Health and Safety is a fundamental consideration for all designers, with both a legal and professional responsibility to ensure understanding and application of health and safety principles at all times.



Rame and Stonehouse CDM fully accepts their obligations and responsibilities, which will be achieved by:

- Meeting its responsibilities as an employer to do all that is reasonably practicable to prevent accidents, injuries and damage to health
- Providing and maintaining safe working environments that are without risks to health, safety and welfare
- Setting standards and providing adequate resources that comply with the relevant statutory legislation relating to health, safety and welfare
- Regularly monitoring and revising this policy and Health & Safety system as necessary, particularly as the business changes in nature and size
- Conducting relevant risk assessments and taking action
- Providing adequate training and communicating the Health & Safety Policy to employees and making it available to all others, including contractors, sub-contractors, and employees of others (where applicable) in the course of their work and the general public, who may be affected by its undertakings
- Complying with the requirements of the Construction (Design and Management) Regulations 2015 that when preparing or modifying designs, to eliminate, reduce or control foreseeable risks that may arise at pre-construction, during construction and the maintenance and use of a building once it is built

This policy, supported by the procedures and organisational arrangements in place, is to be applied to all activities and projects carried out by Rame and Stonehouse CDM.
